Computer Security



First Rule of Security

Never click a link to download a file that you didn't ask for. If the browser says you need to load a new app to continue, make sure you need it and then go find it yourself in your app store.

Apple App Store – Apps a vetted and very unlikely to contain malware. Apple is a closed system so it limits what you get get and do. This is a good trade-off for security.

Android Apps – It is always safer to get them from the Google Play store. They have similar security to Apple. Apps loaded from random web sites have no security. You must know that you trust that site.

Set up Limited User Account

- If you are running Windows, set up a new administrator account and change your current account to a limited user.
- This can protect you from most browser based exploits.
- It requires you to enter your admin password more often, whenever you add software or do some administrator function, but the added security is worth it. Macs and Linux set you up this way by default.
- Remember, 100% of the IE exploits, which is the main way malware gets in, were blocked during all of 2013, if you just weren't an admin user. 100% of them. And what is it, in the 90s, of like the other...Leo: It's 92% for operating system exploits, yeah.



Do I need Antivirus?

Current Security people feel that you should not use 3rd party Antivirus products. They become an irresistible target to bad guys and have to compromise the security of you computer in order to function.


Windows has Windows Defender that is available to you. You have to trust Microsoft because you are using windows so it make sense to use security software that is part of the operating system.



ProXPN VPN service


A Virtual Private Network (VPN) is used to make your connection secure from a public WiFi place. It protects you from snoopers in the coffee shop and keeps your ISP from tracking where you go on the web.

There are many VPN services. Another one that is well recommended is ExpressVPN



Ad Blocking Ublock Origin

Very effective ad blocking. This blocks ads that come from 3rd party sites, by only allowing stuff from the same site as you are visiting. This is easy to turn off on a site by site basis if you need to. Some sites survive by ad revenue so you can choose to see their ads and help them. This has add-ons for all browsers.



Editorial Perspective



Piano Moment, Wonderful Moment

By Ed Sutton, RPT Journal Editorial Staff

Mindfulness trainers remind us to stay in the moment, and that is good advice. But as I sit happily in my present moment, I wonder, has anyone defined how big a moment is, how long, how high or wide, how many dimensions it has? Maybe a moment is as long, tall and wide as you can make it, as rich and full as you can make it. As you tune a unison, can you feel connected to the first people who plucked a stretched sinew or vine and heard a new sound, a sound not like any other sound in their worlds? Can you feel the wonder of the first persons who learned to fix that big, crude string to a hollow tree trunk and to play the sound? That Paleolithic string drum was once the forefront of musical instrument technology! That first hearing and playing is where the piano in front of you comes from, and the piano you are tuning exists to satisfy that same human need to play, organize and give meaning to sound, a need that exists in you and me, as it did in our predecessors millennia ago.

Shortening our conscious moment a bit, this issue of the Journal begins with the era of the Viennese pianoforte, a piano that took an established form by the end of the 18th century, and advanced and flourished until about 1850. The Viennese action could not be well adapted to play increasingly heavy hammers, though it continued in use for the rest of the 19th century. But from about 1780 through 1840, it was the piano of choice of the composers who created much of the canon of what today we call classical music.


One thing we learn by studying this era is that the piano moment is ever-changing and growing. If we think we know exactly what a piano is, how to prepare it and tune it, we might do well to extend our moment. If there is a front edge to our moment, we might want to prepare to catch a ride on the next wave as it passes us, hoping it will lift us rather than wash us away.

Notice the roles that people play in this moment: Stein, Streicher, Haydn, Beethoven, Schumann, Brahms, Hood, Bilson, Fandrich, Barenboim, Maene. Every one of these people has a role in the big story, and the story is not finished. It may be getting ready to take an


